

ORDINANCE NO. 135

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR PRESERVING PUBLIC PROPERTY AND TO PROMOTE AND PRESERVE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE IN THE BOROUGH OF COKEBURG PARK, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF SUCH REGULATIONS.

In order to promote the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Cokeburg Borough, Washington County, Pennsylvania, IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by Authority of the same, in pursuance of the authority granted to Boroughs under the Borough Code and the amendments thereto.

SECTION I - PARK HOURS

The park shall be open from sunrise to sunset or 9:00 P.M. Eastern Standard Time whichever is later, unless otherwise posted. No person without an official permit shall remain in the park under any circumstance during the hours the park is closed.

SECTION II - PARK PROTECTION

No person shall destroy, deface or damage any structure, equipment or fixture therein, or any property of Cokeburg Borough located within the park area.

SECTION III - REFUSE DISPOSAL

No person shall dispose of any rubbish or garbage except in receptacles designated for such purpose.

SECTION IV - GLASS CONTAINERS

The use of glass bottles or glass containers of any kind is prohibited in order to prevent injury or damage to persons or property by broken glass.

SECTION V - WEAPONS OR EXPLOSIVES

Possession or discharge of any firearms, bow and arrows, or any type of weapon or explosives, including firecrackers, is prohibited unless specific areas are designated for their use and permission is granted in writing by the borough.

SECTION VI - BEHAVIOR

No person shall conduct herself or himself in any manner which causes harm to health, safety, morals or general welfare of any person within the park. Creating excessive noise, drunkenness, disorderly or indecent conduct, profane and offensive language are hereby prohibited. Possession or use of narcotic drugs is prohibited.

SECTION VII - DOMESTIC ANIMALS AND PETS

No domestic animals or pets are permitted in the Park Area except on a leash.

SECTION VIII - SOLICITING

No person shall post any signs, solicit, peddle or offer any article for sale or service within the Park Area or set up a stand or booth for such purpose without a permit from the Borough.

SECTION IX - ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

No alcoholic beverages are permitted in the park except where restricted to specific areas by permit for picnics upon permission by the Borough Council. No alcoholic beverages may be possessed or consumed by any minor.

SECTION X - PARK FACILITIES

All park facilities shall be used only for their intended purposes. It is prohibited to move picnic tables or any other type of park facility.

SECTION XI - MOTOR VEHICLES

No vehicle of any type is permitted in the park except automobiles, motorcycles and trucks which shall be confined to the designated parking areas.

SECTION XII - SPECIAL PERMITS FOR  
THE BALL PARK

The use of the Ball Park Area shall be by permit only; issued by Cokeburg Borough Council. Cokeburg Baseball League must get a permit, but shall be exempt from the cleaning fee if the field and surrounding area are cleaned after each practice and game. Cokeburg Baseball League is also responsible for visiting teams and their refuse. Any and all other baseball and softball games shall be conducted by permit only and post a fifty dollar (\$50.00) clean up fee. The fee shall be returned when the field and surrounding areas are cleaned and all refuse put in the proper receptacles the same day of the practice or the game.

SECTION XIII - PENALTIES

Any person who shall violate any of the rules and regulations contained in this ordinance shall, upon summary conviction thereof, before a District Magistrate be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) and costs of prosecution for each and every offense, or to undergo imprisonment in the Washington County Jail for not more than ten (10) days.

SECTION XIV - ENFORCEMENT

The rules and regulations of this ordinance shall be enforced by the Cokeburg Borough Police Department. This ordinance is not intended to limit any violations of the Pennsylvania Crimes Code, the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code or any other municipal, county, or state law. This ordinance shall also be enforced by Cokeburg Borough Council and its employees.

SECTION XV - CONFLICTS

Any ordinance or part thereof conflicting with this ordinance is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.

SECTION XVI - UNCONSTITUTIONALITY

If any sentence, clause of section or part of this ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions. declared as the intent of the Borough Council that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included therein.
