JVS Environmental is announcing the 2020 dates for their PERMANENT ELECTRONICS RECYCLING FACILITY, located at 1 American Way in Ellsworth. The site is located behind the Ellsworth Post Office (1002 Almond Road, Ellsworth, PA 15331). Participants will enter the site from Almond Road, past the Beer Here Beer Distributor. JVS Environmental will be managing the site. This site will replace the monthly electronics collection program that was previously held at the Washington County Fairgrounds, then at the Washington Mall site.

**The site will be open on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday of each month from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. Here are the dates for 2020:**

Items to be collected include computer monitors (CRTs and LCDs); computer towers and bases (CPUs); mice, keyboards and speakers; notebook computers; printers; televisions (CRTs and LCDs); Freon appliances; fluorescent tubes and CFL bulbs; and most household appliances. Vacuum cleaners, carpet scrubbers, smoke detectors, and carbon monoxide detectors will **NOT** be accepted. **Most items will be collected free of charge.**

- **NEW FOR 2020 – No restrictions on number of TVs accepted on the collection days.**
- Damaged or dismantled CRT TVs will be accepted for a \$50 hazardous handling fee.
- 4- and 8-foot fluorescent tubes and Compact Fluorescent Lights (CFL) will be accepted for a charge of \$2 per bulb.
- Freon appliances will be accepted, with a Freon removal fee of \$20
