

**Ordinance Number 214**  
**Amending Ordinance Number 174**  
**Vehicular Use of Streets**

An ordinance of the Borough of Cokeburg amending Ordinance Number 174 regulating vehicular use of streets and sidewalks.

Ordinance Number 174 entitled Vehicular Use of Streets is hereby amended as follows:

Section Nos. 1-7: Unchanged

Section No. 8 PARKING PROHIBITED at ALL TIMES

No person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any streets or parts thereof.

Section #9 REPEALED

Section #10 VIOLATIONS and PENALTIES

Any person violating any part of this ordinance, with the exception of 4J, shall, upon conviction, pay a fine of \$100.00, as well as the costs of prosecution.

Any person violating Section 4J of this ordinance, shall, upon conviction, pay a fine of \$100.00, as well as the costs of prosecution.

Any person who willfully defaults in payment of any fine or costs shall be committed to the County Correctional Facility for a number of days equal to one (1) day for each \$25.00 of the unpaid balance of the fine and costs.

Upon plea and proof that a person is unable to pay any fine and costs imposed under this section, a court may order payment of the fine and costs in installments and shall fix the amounts, times and manner of payment.

Any person who does not comply with an installment payment order entered under this section shall be committed to the County Correctional Facility for a number of days equal to one (1) day for each \$50.00 of the unpaid balance of the fine and costs.

In addition any vehicle which is found parked in violation of Section No. 8 of this ordinance will be tagged by the code enforcement officer or other designated official of the borough and if not removed within twenty four (24) hours or upon a second or subsequent occurrence, may

be towed or booted at the discretion of the code enforcement officer or designated official of the borough.

Section #11 CONFLICTING ORDINANCES REPEALED

That any ordinance, or part of any ordinance, conflicting with this ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section #12 EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall become effective on date of enactment.
